

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR LAKEVIEW POLICE DEPARTMENT
FOR THE CITIES OF TAYLOR LAKE VILLAGE AND EL LAGO, TX
HELD ON SEPTEMBER 12, 2022, AT 98 LAKESHORE DR., EL LAGO, TX**

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Corbin called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. with the above listed personnel present. The Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America was recited.

2. ADOPTION OF MINUTES:

The minutes of the regular meeting held on August 15, 2022, were approved after a motion from Commissioner O'Donel and second from Commissioner Corbin. Minutes passed with all in favor.

3. CHAIRMAN AND COMMISSIONS REPORTS: None.

4. MAYORS AND COUNCIL MEMBERS COMMENTS (El Lago and Taylor Lake Village):

Councilman Michalak thanked Chief Nunn for a smooth and non-contentious police budget process. Chief Nunn reported line-items were slightly adjusted, but the final amount will remain the same.

5. CITIZEN'S COMMENTS: None.

6. POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT:

a) Traffic Enforcement, Case Reports, Meetings, Personnel:

Hot spot report presented. Commissioner Delly stated that he was approached about speeding vehicles and large trucks cutting through the subdivision on Forest Lake Dr. Chief Nunn said he spoke with the city and there is no ordinance about trucks, but that the city is considering "NO THRU TRUCKS" signs. Commissioner Delly reported the president of Clear Lake Forest HOA is speaking with CCISD about a school crossing guard for mornings and afternoons. Chief Nunn advised there is a possibility to implement school zones in the 400-600 block of Forest Lake and Shady Springs between Lori Ln. and Forest Lake. Commissioner Keuhnel commented of the warrant collections by Officer Blacksmith is working out very well. Cases of interest discussed and explained. Chief Nunn updated Commissioners on vacancies and applicant status. Part-time employee David Martin is considering full-time position.

b) Monthly Activity Report for August 2022:

Commissioner Hall inquired about an incident that happened at the Kirby Woods pool not mentioned in the report. Chief Nunn advised resident was located and counselled.

c) Financial Report through August 2022:

Narcotics account funds will be used to purchase ballistic shields

d) 2022-2023 Final Budget:

Final version presented. Two pay periods to go in this FY. Commissioner Keuhnel inquired about Dispatching costs and if overrun to continue. Chief Nunn explained the increase is based on activity and call volume. Switching from Comcast to PS Lightwave will save the PD \$2700.00 annually. Insurance will increase with adding a new car.

7. Adjournment:

Chairman Corbin moved for adjournment. The meeting was adjourned at 6:27 p.m.
